

BACKGROUND

- 3DE is an instructional model implemented in existing public high schools in partnership with Junior Achievement, local school districts, and local business/philanthropic communities.
- Focus on <u>competency development</u>, <u>business case methodology</u>, and <u>entrepreneurship</u>
 makes learning more relevant and experiential to better prepare young people for <u>modern</u>
 workforce needs
- School-within-a-school model typically composing of one-third of host high school's student population reflective of the demographics of local student population.
- Part of a national movement launched in 2015, 3DE currently serves 3,300 students in 12 schools in Florida across 7 school districts.
- More than 100 specially trained 3DE teachers employed by school districts.
- Case partners representing more than **50 businesses** providing students career exposure to a wide range of industries including cybersecurity, IT, manufacturing, and construction, and more through co-branded curriculum and volunteer engagements.
